# Information about our processing of personal data

Updated: May 2024

### **INTRODUCTION**

In this information about our processing of personal data, we describe what personal data about you that we use and why and what rights you have in relation to your personal data under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

This information about our processing of personal data is divided into two parts:

- This **general information**, which for example describes from which sources we collect personal data, for which purposes we process personal data, and how we share personal data.
- A **detailed information**, which for example describes which categories of personal data that are being processed for each purpose and based on which legal basis, including for how long the personal data is stored for each purpose.

#### PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

**Personal data** means any information that, directly or indirectly, can be related to an identified or identifiable individual. Examples of personal data are your name, e-mail address, or IP address.

**Processing** means any action taken in relation to personal data, for example collection, storage and transmission. Each processing of personal data must be carried out for a specific purpose. We outline further below for which purposes we process personal data.

### WHO IS COVERED BY THIS INFORMATION

This information covers you who:

- Represent or who are a contact person of a customer, supplier or business partners to us.
- Visits our websites and our digital channels, for example our pages on social media platforms.
- Otherwise interact with us, for example in connection with communication or meetings.

# RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Lakeway Link AB, company registration number 559441-3410, ("we", "us" or "our") is responsible (controller) for the collection and processing of your personal data as described in this information.

### FROM WHICH SOURCES WE COLLECT PERSONAL DATA

The personal data that we collect about you is mainly collected directly from yourself when you provide your personal data to us, for example when we interact with you or when you otherwise communicate with us.

We also collect, where necessary, personal data from other sources:

- The company or organisation that you work for, and which provides your personal to us.
- **Group companies** that have collected your personal data, for example when interacting with you, and provide your personal data to us.
- **Business partners**, that we collaborate with, and which have collected your personal data, for example when interacting with you or in connection with a meeting, event or similar activity, and which provide your personal data to us.

- **Social media platforms**, if you follow or interact with us on social media platforms or if we otherwise collect your personal from such platforms.
- Publicly available sources, for example information online and available in public records.
- External persons that that we communicate or otherwise interact with for the purposes described in this information.

### FOR WHICH PURPOSES WE PROCESS PERSONAL DATA

Below we describe for which purposes we process personal data. For which purposes we process your personal data may vary depending on, among other things, your relationship with us and how you interact with us, please see below.

### Contact persons of customers, suppliers and business partners

If you are a contact person of a customer, supplier or business partner, we process your personal data to:

- Prepare and carry out procurements
- Manage the business relationship
- Manage orders of goods and services from customers and suppliers
- Carry out analysis for obtaining insights to develop and improve our business, our strategies and business methods
- Follow-up on and analyse sales
- Follow-up on and analyse the business relationship with our customers, suppliers and business partners
- Provide offers and marketing
- Carry out trainings and product demonstrations

Customers, suppliers and business partners also include prospective customers, suppliers and business partners.

# Users of our website and digital channels

If you visit our website and our digital channels we process your personal data to:

- Follow-up on and analyse the use of our website and digital channels
- Communicate information about our services and products
- Communicate and interact with you in our digital channels

### All categories of individuals above and other external persons

In relation to all categories of individuals stated above and other external persons, we process personal data to:

- Communicate about us and our business
- Follow up and evaluate our communication
- <u>Carry out meetings, events, and similar activities</u>
- Follow-up on and evaluate activities carried out
- Respond to questions and requests
- Carry out surveys
- Provide newsletters
- Communicate in the course of the business
- Document and record decisions and supporting information in the course of the business
- Manage sale and restructuring of all or parts of the business
- Manage, defend and exercise legal claims
- Ensure technical functionality and security in our IT systems
- Fulfill legal obligations
- Respond to legal requests
- Protect and ensure the safety of our staff and assets

### **HOW WE SHARE PERSONAL DATA**

# Transfer of personal data to other external recipients (controllers)

We share, where necessary, your personal data with the following recipients:

- The **company or organisation** that you work for, for example to manage the business relationship with the company or organisation.
- **Group companies** for various purposes, for example to communicate with you. For information about which group companies that are a part of Soya Group, please visit Soya Group's <u>website</u>.
- **Business partners**, for example in connection with meetings, events or similar activities.
- External persons, that we communicate or otherwise interact with for the purposes described in this information.
- Other recipients, for example authorities, courts and external advisors in certain situations, including to fulfil our legal obligations or to manage, defend and exercise legal claims.

# Transfer of personal data to service providers (processors)

We also transfer personal data to service providers that we have engaged when necessary for the purposes for which we process personal data as described in this information. Examples of service providers are external IT

suppliers and suppliers of communication services.

Moreover, Soya Group Support AB provides internal shared services, such as finance and IT services, to group companies. Where Soya Group Support processes personal data on our behalf, the company acts as a processor to us.

The services providers which process personal data on our behalf and in accordance with our instructions act as data processors in relation to us. These service providers may not process your personal data for their own purposes and are legally and contractually obligated to protect your personal data.

### Where we process your personal data

We store your personal data within the EU/EEA.

Additionally, we transfer, in certain cases, your personal data to recipients located in third countries outside the EU/EEA, for example to service providers which we engage in such third country.

To ensure an essentially equivalent level of protection for your personal data when transferred (or otherwise made available) to service providers in third countries outside of the EU/EEA, which do not provide an adequate level of protection, we normally use the EU Commission's adopted <u>standard contractual clauses for international transfers</u> according to decision 2021/914 and implement – in light of the law and practices of the third country – necessary supplementary measures to ensure an essentially equivalent level of protection of the personal data transferred.

We also rely upon adequacy decisions by the EU Commission where personal data is transferred to countries and recipients covered by such decision. Adequacy decisions are issued by the EU Commission when it has decided that such country or recipient provides an adequate protection for personal data.

# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON YOUR RIGHTS**

You have certain rights in relation to your personal data under the GDPR.

You have the right to:

- Access to and receive a copy of your personal data together with additional information on our processing of your personal data.
- **Rectification** of or request that we supplement your personal data if you consider that your personal data is incorrect, incomplete, or misleading.
- Erasure of your personal data.
- **Object** to our processing of your personal data, for example our processing of your personal data for direct marketing purposes or when we rely on a legitimate interest for the processing.
- **Restrict** our processing of your personal data, which means that you can, at least for a certain period, stop us from using your personal data (other than storing your personal data).
- Obtain a copy of the personal data that you have provided to us in a structured and commonly used format and, where it is technically feasible, have this personal data transferred to an external recipient (data portability).
- Withdraw your consent to processing of your personal data when we rely on your consent for the processing.

• Lodge a complaint with your supervisory authority. In Sweden, we are under the supervision of the Swedish Authority for Privacy Protection (IMY).

### **Exercise your rights**

If possible, we would grateful if you use the e-mail address that you have registered with us or used when previously being in contact with us. This would facilitate our handling of your request.

### We normally respond to your request within one month

We normally respond to your request within one month following the date we received your request. However, if your request is complicated or if you have submitted several requests, we may need additional time to handle your request. We will in such a case notify you and the reasons of the delay at the latest within one month from when your request was submitted. If we cannot, wholly or in part, comply with your request we will notify you and the reasons for this within one month from when your request was submitted. If you have submitted your request electronically, for example contacted us via the website or via e-mail, we will respond to the request electronically, unless you request otherwise.

### We need to confirm your identity in order to respond to your request

When you submit a request to exercise your rights, we need to confirm your identity to ensure that you are not somebody else than who you claim to be. This to avoid that we for example disclose personal data to an unauthorised person or in error delete personal data. If we do not have sufficient information to confirm your identity, we can request that you provide supplementary information about yourself to confirm your identity. We only request such information that is reasonable and necessary to your identity. The time to respond to your request starts when we have confirmed your identity.

### **Automated individual decision-making**

We do not carry out any automated individual decision-making which have legal effects or similar significant effects on you.

### **USE OF COOKIES AND SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES**

We use cookies and similar technologies on our website. This to, among other things, collect statistics in order to better understand how our website are used. This allows us to develop and improve our website to provide a better user experience.

In our cookie information, we describe how we use cookies and similar technologies, for which purposes and what options and settings you may choose for our cookies.

### **Updates to this information**

We do not carry out any profiling as a part of the processing of personal data for this purpose, since we are not interested in your specific behaviour or interests.

Your opinions about our business and services are important to us and necessary in order for us to improve our business and services. We may use your personal data that we have collected at an earlier stage (for example to manage our business relationship) for this purpose as well.

You can always unsubscribe from our communication about surveys by clicking on the unsubscribe link in the email or similar communication field or by contacting us.
